Description	<p>UAS BFI Vienna currently offers an elective module for students from "Logistics and Transport Management (LOGT)", dealing with politics, economics and doing business in the Black Sea Region. The course is open for BA students. It comprises three seminars. The first one deals with the (geo-)political and institutional environment of the BSR (countries). The second one deals with economics and doing business in the BSR. From a theoretical point of view, both courses draw on the political risk concept. The third seminar is a study excursion, taking the students to one of the BSR countries where a number of meetings with international, governmental and non-governmental agencies as well as companies provide them with an in-depth and practical insight into the country's business environment. Applying the concepts of the two prior courses to the real context is the aim of this study trip.</p> <p>For the purpose of EUCON, we will revise the BSR Elective. In future, seminar one will include the topic of conflict, competition and cooperation between the EU and the EEU into the seminar programme at the extent of 4 teaching units. Moreover, the excursion will go to an EaP/EEU country, such as Georgia, where the students will deal with the topic of EUCON by meeting local experts and practitioners.</p>			
Impact	<p>Similar to teaching activity Nr. 1, students will develop specific knowledge concerning EU-EEU relations and their impact on enterprises. The excursion will be a decisive tool to gain first hand insights in regards to conflict, competition and cooperation between the EU and the EEU. In this context, the students furthermore gain direct impressions of how the topic shapes a country culturally, politically and socioeconomically.</p>
